Discussion:
- 2016 pilot project was a success with businesses reporting the best Canada Day ever
 - Event overview and budget proposed by the Chamber of Commerce (Provided)
 - Requires Early Budget approval to secure entertainers and staging
 - Requesting \$8000 from the District with an additional \$14,000 to be provided by sponsorship
 - District staff confirmed that \$4000 is available from the existing Canada Day budget for entertainment
 - Current Canada Day budget is \$17,532
 - Other initiatives to explore for Canada Day:
 - Aquatic Event (i.e.: Paddleboard, Yacht Club parade of lights, Dragonboat, etc.)
 - WFN involvement (Canada day and beyond – war canoes, traditional food)
