Heritage Park Splash Pad – Waiver of Requirement for Washroom Facility

Peachland, BC – As agreed upon at the April 25, 2022 Special Council Meeting, the District of Peachland’s Chief Administrative Officer and Director of Operations continued discussions with the Interior Health Authority (IHA), including a meeting at the Heritage Park Splash Pad site. As a result of the meeting Interior Health has agreed to waive the requirement for a new washroom and water fountain for Heritage Park.

Interior Health has indicated that as a result of the waiver, the washroom facility for the Heritage Park Splash Pad will be the existing one across Beach Avenue. The District of Peachland will increase safety at the crosswalk on Beach Avenue for access to the existing washrooms. Furthermore, the water fountain for the Heritage Park Splash Pad will be at the north end of the existing playground.

“Council and District Staff are grateful to the Interior Health Authority for their reconsideration on this matter, especially during an extremely busy time within their organization.” said Mayor Fortin.

CAO Joe Creron will be bringing a report to Council in the near future for consideration on what should be done with the existing washroom and an evaluation of other needs within the park.
