Parks, Facilities and Recreation Services open:

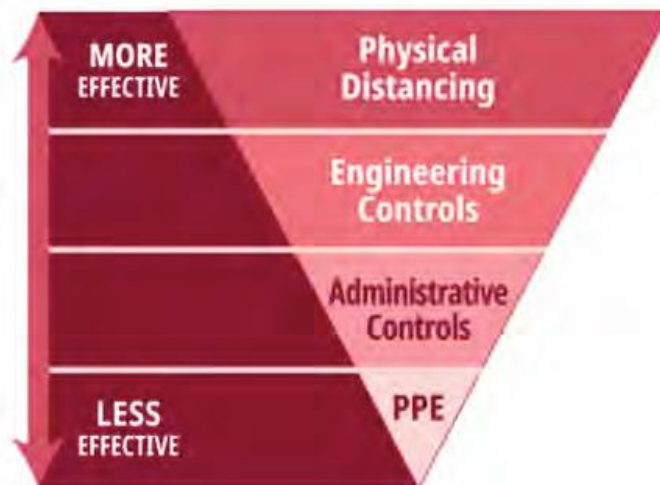

Operationalizing recreation programs and services will need to consider the Hierarchy of Controls for COVID-19 as well the Worksafe BC Covid-19 Safety Plans:

Hierarchy of Controls For COVID-19

The hierarchy of controls is a framework for reducing transmission hazards. The most effective controls are at the top of the pyramid.

Special conditions during COVID-19

Cleaning and disinfection frequency:

- Playgrounds and outdoor touch services are not cleaned nor disinfected
- Outside washrooms are cleaned/disinfected twice a day (midday and after closure)

- Inside facilities open to the public will have high touch surfaces cleaned/disinfected twice a day
- (midday and after closure)
- Fitness/recreation programs will not share equipment between users. Equipment will be cleaned/disinfected after use

Swim Bay:

- Closure of low dive board to allow lifeguard staff to position self away from the public
- Closure of zipline and rope swing as amenities cannot be effectively cleaned nor disinfected
- Lifeguard service restricted to the zone between the yacht club and the dive tower
- Swimming lessons only for Swimkids levels 4-10 (ages 6 years and over) as younger children require hands-on assistance when learning
- Lifeguards trained on COVID-19 first aid and rescue modifications
- Enhanced Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) requirements adapted for staff
- Float docks and high dive remain open
- Delayed start to accommodate specialized training – Opening date will be June 30, 2020

Registered Programs:

- Informed consents/waivers required for all programs regardless of risk level with COVID-19 precautions
- Safety plan developed and reviewed with contract instructors

Facility/Park Rentals:

- Rental agreements updated with MIA recommended COVID-19 language
- Renter must provide a COVID-19 Safety Plan (for sports- the local or provincial sport organization must approve the plan)
