Traffic along Highway 97 has returned to normal after a small slide caused traffic disruptions north of Antlers Beach in Peachland earlier this afternoon. The slide area has been stabilized, and personnel will remain on site throughout the night to monitor the situation.

BC Hydro has restored power to most customers. The ruptured sewer main has been isolated and the service has been restored to most customers in a limited capacity. We are still requesting that residents in the Renfrew Road, Ferguson Place, Sherburn Road, Stuart Crescent and 6469 – 6544 Bulyea Avenue areas reduce their water and sewer use as much as possible (minimal flushing, showers, laundry, dishwasher use) until further notice. Staff are working to ensure the remaining homeowners are looked after while repairs are completed.

We would like to thank the residents for their patience and understanding during this emergency situation. Our thanks also go out to our contractors, BC Hydro, Ministry of Transportation, and our staff and volunteers who responded quickly to get this situation resolved.

We will post updates on the District of Peachland website as the situation changes, or more information becomes available.
