Peachland Demonstration Xeriscape Project

The District of Peachland, in partnership with the Okanagan Basin Water Board (OBWB) and Okanagan Xeriscape Association (OXA), held a contest where two lucky homeowners were selected to have their thirsty lawn front yards renovated to a low-water, low-maintenance xeriscape design for demonstration and water consumption analysis.

The planting was completed in November 2016 and the project sites are now ready to visit. The public is encouraged to visit the sites at 3904 Beach Avenue and 4032 Smith Way in Peachland. The overall intent of this pilot project is to show the aesthetic appeal and measure the water conservation that can be achieved through xeriscape landscaping. A three-year water consumption analysis will follow.

This project was made possible with the support of an Okanagan Basin Water Board Water Conservation and Quality Improvement Grant and its Okanagan WaterWise program, the Okanagan Xeriscape Association, Waterwise Xeriscape Design, Old World Landscaping, Manchester Signs, and Westside Equipment Rentals.
