The District of Peachland is accepting applications for a Temporary Gardener. Reporting to the Director of Community Services this position performs a variety of landscaping maintenance and building maintenance functions for the District.

Key Job Duties:

- Landscaping functions such as mowing, trimming, pruning, planting, fertilizing, spraying
- Garbage pickup from beaches and parks
- Building maintenance
- Snow removal by hand and with small equipment

Hours of Work

This temporary position terminates upon the return of the incumbent.

The normal work day shall consist of a scheduled period of up to eight consecutive hours of work and the normal work week shall consist of up to five consecutive days, followed by two consecutive days off. The shift for this position is Sunday - Thursday.
