The District of Peachland is currently recruiting for a Casual/On Call Building Inspector.

Reporting to the Director of Planning & Development Services, this casual position's hours of work will vary, on an as needed basis depending on workload. The overall responsibility for administration of the District's building regulations, bylaws and relevant provincial and federal legislation.

Duties of the Building Inspector relate to a variety of responsibilities, including:

- Administration of Building Inspection, including Building Permit issuance, ensuring construction, conversion, demolition, renovation, repairs and additions to buildings and structures comply with BC Building Code, District Bylaws and relevant legislation;
- Plan examination of building permit application;
- Preparation of reports and records, as required.

Qualifications:

- Completion of recognized trades qualification in carpentry and plumbing, or 2-year Technical Diploma related to Architecture, or Structural Engineering Technology;
- Level 3 certification with BOABC (Building Official's Association of BC);
- Valid BC Class 5 Drivers License;
- 4 years related experiences or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience.
- Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing and to deal courteously, tactfully, impartially and firmly with public, contractors and trades people.

This is a CUPE Local 608 position with a rate of \$44.22 per hour plus 15% in lieu of benefits.
