

Know **BEFORE** you ride in *Peachland*

As more e-scooters and e-dirt bikes are seen around our community, the District of Peachland is sharing information to help parents and riders understand the rules, improve safety and prevent injuries.



E-SCOOTERS AND E-DIRT BIKES ARE **NOT PERMITTED** ON ROADS OR SIDEWALKS IN PEACHLAND

E-SCOOTERS



Not permitted on roads, sidewalks, bike lanes or multi-use paths in Peachland.



Peachland is **not** participating in BC's Electric Kick Scooter Pilot Project.

E-BIKES



Permitted where bicycles are allowed.



Follow bicycle traffic safety laws and wear a helmet. Minimum rider age; 14 for light e-bikes and 16 for standard e-bikes.

E-DIRT BIKES/ MOTORCYCLES



Permitted only on private property or approved off-road areas.



Not permitted on public roads, sidewalks, bike lanes, trails, sports fields or parks.



RIDE RESPONSIBLY.

Enforcement action may be taken when riders operate devices illegally or create safety risks.
