As a member of the team, you will provide aquatic supervision, emergency response, first aid, public safety, swim lesson instruction, and will serve as an ambassador of the town.

Key Responsibilities

- Safety supervision of public swim participants, enforcement of facility and industry safety standards, and related public relations.
- First aid and emergency response, including appropriate documentation.
- Develop and teach high-quality swim lessons for all ages.
- Maintain accurate, up to date records for bather loads, weather and water conditions, and incident/accident logs.
- Engage with a diverse patron base to provide exceptional service and public education.
- Provide a clean and safe swimming experience.

Hours of Work

Hours of work and rate of pay are in accordance with the Collective Agreement between the District of Peachland and the Canadian Union of Public Employees Local #609.

Full Time

- 35 hours per week – 5 consecutive 7 hour shifts between 9:30 am and 6:00 pm
- Includes weekend shifts
- Rate of pay is \$27.33 per hour with 15% paid in lieu of benefits and vacation

Part Time

- Various hours between 9:30 am and 6:00 pm (Monday - Sunday)
- Includes weekend shifts
- Rate of pay is \$27.33 per hour with 15% paid in lieu of benefits and vacation
