

Bulletin: Moving a Building

Purpose

To inform building contractors and the general public of the requirements for moving a building into, out of or within the District of Peachland.

Requirements

These are the permits/services that you will be required to obtain from the District of Peachland prior to movement and/or placement of any house, mobile home, building, or structure in to, out of or within the District of Peachland.

3.7 This bylaw applies if the whole or any part of an existing building is moved either within or into the District, including relocation relative to parcel lines created by subdivision or consolidation. Part 12 of this bylaw applies to building moves.

Building Move

- **12.1** No person may move a *building* or *structure* into or within the District:
- (a) except where certified by a registered professional that the building, including its foundation, will substantially comply with the current version of the building code; and
- (b) a building permit has been issued for the building or structure.

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□ **Demolition Permit from Building Dept**. – to ensure the site where the building is removed is restored to a safe condition after removal.

<u>Building Application</u> provided for demolition permit – information required as per Conditions of Permit listed below.

- Building Permit Application submitted.
- Safety measures at construction and demolition sites to be in accordance with Division B - Part 8 of the BC Building Code 2018.
- Call for inspection when demolition complete and site restored to safe condition.

- ☐ Contact all other relevant Utility providers for service disconnects and further information. (Hydro, telephone, gas, cable etc.)

NOTE: A Business License is required for contractors and movers involved. All permits listed above must be in place and approved prior to any movement of the building.
