



Bulletin: Solid-Fuel-Burning Appliance Installations

Purpose

To inform the Community of the District of Peachland's requirements for the installation of solid-fuel-burning appliances and equipment.

Components

There are three components to a wood appliance:

1. The appliance itself
 - a. Conforming to CAN/ULC-S610-M87 Factory Built Fireplaces
 - b. Conforming to ULC-S628-93 Fireplace inserts
 - c. Conforming to the BC Building Code 9.33.5.3. and CAN/CSA-B365-10 Installation Code for Solid-Fuel-Burning Appliances and Equipment
2. The flue pipe and chimney
 - a. Conforming to CAN/ULC Standard S629-M87 650 Factory-Built Chimneys
 - b. Conforming to the BC Building Code (latest version) Section 9.21. Masonry and Concrete Chimneys and Flues
3. The combustion air supply
 - a. Conforming to the BC Building Code 9.33.5.3. and CAN/CSA-B365-10 Installation Code for Solid-Fuel Burning Appliances & Equipment

It is recommended that a "WETT" certified installer completes the installation and leaves behind his certification report. All of the manufacturer's documentation for all three components must also be left on site for the building inspector to confirm the installation is correct. CHECK: To see if you will also require this for your home insurance.

If all the components are new and the homeowner is performing the installation, all of the manufacturer's documentation for all three components must be left on site for the building inspector to confirm the installation is correct.

If any of the components are in a "used" condition, a "WETT" certified installer must complete the installation and leave behind their certification report. All of the manufacturer's documentation for all three components must be left on site for the building inspector to confirm the installation is correct.

Note: *these are general guidelines only, check with the building inspector for specifics. If the inspector cannot see complete installation (e.g.: chimney clearance) a WETT report is required.*
