BYLAW NUMBER 2460

A Bylaw to Impose a Parcel Tax under the Provisions of the *Community Charter*

WHEREAS the District of Peachland will provide funding for the initiation and construction phase of the Protective Services Building Project as the result of the planning and design costs and subsequently debt incurred for the construction of the Protective Services Building Project:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient to impose and levy a Parcel Tax to meet such costs;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the District of Peachland, in open meeting assembled,

HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Bylaw:

"Parcel" means any lot, block or other area, including lots created under the *Condominium Act*, in which land is held or into which it is subdivided, but does not include highways;

"Group of Parcels" means, where a building or other improvement extends over more than one parcel of land, those parcels, if contiguous may be treated by the Assessor as one parcel and assessed accordingly.

2. A tax shall be levied on each parcel or group of parcels of real property within the Corporation of the District of Peachland which is within the boundaries of the Corporation of the District of Peachland, other than those that are exempt from the tax.
3. The annual tax for the year 2026 shall be in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per parcel or group of parcels.
4. The Protective Services Building Project Parcel Tax Assessment Roll was originally authenticated on April 9, 2024 by a Parcel Tax Review Panel appointed under the *Community Charter*.
5. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Protective Services Building Project Parcel Tax Bylaw Number 2460."
