



## **DISTRICT OF PEACHLAND Water Treatment Operator – Level II, III, IV**

The District of Peachland, a vibrant and growing community of approximately 5,800 located on the shores of Okanagan Lake between Kelowna and Penticton, is seeking a dedicated and qualified individual to join our team as a permanent fulltime Water Treatment Operator.

Reporting to the Chief Water Treatment Operator with support from the Manager of Utilities, this position's primary focus is the operation and maintenance of all aspects of the District's Peachland Creek water treatment plant with a secondary focus of assisting, as needed, within the water distribution system.

We understand that talent and dedication come in many forms. While a level 4 Environment Operations Certification Program (EOCP) certification is preferred, the District may consider candidates with a lesser set of qualifications if they possess a strong combination of relevant experience, skills, and a commitment to professional development. Factors such as related operational experience, mechanical aptitude, and a proven track record in a related field will be considered.

### **Key Job Duties / Functions**

- Operate and maintain all water treatment and distribution infrastructure in an effective and efficient manner to minimize health risks and environmental concerns
- Maintain and evaluate material, equipment and supplies for continuous operation of the water treatment process
- Complete water quality testing ensuring compliance in processes and finished water meeting local, provincial and federal regulations.

### **Qualifications**

- High School Graduation
- Valid BC Class 5 Drivers License with air endorsement
- Environment Operations Certification Program (EOCP) Water Treatment II, III, IV Certification
- Graduation from a recognized training institute with a Diploma in Water Engineering Technology is preferred
- Typically, three years' related experience is required
- Related experience using SCADA systems and basic software to monitor and report operational data
- EOCP Chlorine Operator handling certification
- Confined space entry certification

Preferred candidate will also possess:

- EOCP Water Distribution II Certification

**Additional Information**

The normal workday shall consist of a scheduled period of up to eight consecutive hours of work and the normal workweek shall consist of up to five consecutive days, followed by two consecutive days off. The regular shift for this position is Monday - Friday.

Staff will also be required to enter the after-hours standby rotation which may require varying hours and response to alarm calls in both the treatment plant and distribution system.

The position will remain open until the position is filled.

The Water Treatment Plant Operator is a CUPE Local 608 position and the hourly pay rate range is \$40.07 to \$45.10 per hour based on certification level and includes a full benefits package.
