The District of Peachland is now accepting applications for Election Officials (10 positions) to support the 2026 Peachland By-Election. This is a great opportunity to contribute to the democratic process and serve your community.

### **About the Role**

Election Officials play a key role in ensuring voting runs smoothly and fairly. Duties include:

- Setting up and taking down the voting location
- Registering voters and issuing ballots
- Assisting voters as required
- Counting ballots after polls close
- Cleaning up the voting location (e.g., removing signage, moving tables and chairs)

### **Work Dates & Hours**

Election Officials must be available to work the following scheduled dates:

- **March 4, 2026** – Advance Voting Day
- **March 11, 2026** – Advance Voting Day
- **March 14, 2026** – General Voting Day

**Shift hours:** 12-hour day

### **Mandatory Training**

Applicants **must** be able to attend a required training session:

- February 26, 2026 at 4:00 p.m.
- Location: Peachland – Council Chambers

### **Applicant Requirements**

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Be legally entitled to work in Canada

- Be able to work a full 12-hour day and remain on site
- Complete a solemn declaration confirming they will perform duties impartially and are not personally connected to any candidate in the election
