E-SCOOTERS



Not permitted on roads, sidewalks, bike lanes or multi-use paths in Peachland.



Peachland is not participating in BC's Electric Kick Scooter Pilot Project.



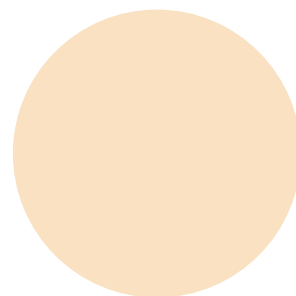
E-BIKES



Permitted where bicycles are allowed.



Follow bicycle traffic safety laws and wear a helmet. Minimum rider age applies under provincial regulations.



E-DIRT BIKES/ MOTORCYCLES



Only on private property or approved off-road areas.



Not permitted on public roads, sidewalks, bike lanes, trails, sports fields or parks.



Enforcement action may be taken when riders operate devices illegally or create safety risks.
