OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN BYLAW AMENDMENT NO. 2466

**Notice is hereby given that Council will hold a Public Hearing on:

Council will hear from anyone who believes their interest in property may be affected, or who wishes to make representations regarding Official Community Plan (OCP) Bylaw Amendment No. 2466.

The District commenced the Minor OCP Review project in 2025 as the current OCP was adopted in June 2018 and was due for review. An OCP is typically reviewed approximately every five years. OCP policies and best practices guide Council's decisions and provide overall direction for other District plans, strategies, and regulatory bylaws.

As this project comprises only a minor OCP review, the amendments are more focused and are largely intended to reflect recent provincially legislated changes that require municipal OCPs and zoning bylaws to be updated to accommodate at least the total anticipated housing needs for the next 20 years as identified in the Interim Housing Needs Report. This minor OCP review includes six key parts:

- growth scenarios
- population projections
- development permit areas and guidelines
- housing policies
- general review and updates
- long-term financial sustainability
