We are currently seeking an Operations Labourer to join our team. This is a full-time, temporary position lasting up to twelve (12) months within the District's Operations Department.

The Operations Labourer performs a wide variety of manual and semi-skilled tasks related to the maintenance and repair of municipal infrastructure, including roads, water and sewer systems, parks, cemetery, and public facilities. This is a physically demanding role suited to someone who enjoys outdoor work, is mechanically inclined, and thrives in a team-oriented environment.

THE SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATE WILL POSSESS THE FOLLOWING COMPETENCIES:

- Ability to perform manual labour such as mowing, trimming, sweeping, brush and tree removal, shoveling, painting, snow removal, and refuse pickup by hand and with small equipment.
- Ability to provide maintenance functions for District water and sewer assets such as rights-of-way, water mains and services, hydrants, valves, manholes, dams, upland lakes, ICs and services.
- Proficient in operating equipment such as lawn mowers, flail mowers, chainsaws, compactors, jackhammers, and dump trucks.
- Competence in general road maintenance including pothole repair, flagging, culvert cleaning, sign replacement, and street sweeping.
- Skilled in cemetery maintenance including grave preparation, landscaping, and upkeep using equipment such as ride-on mowers and weed eaters.
- Familiarity with safety practices in accordance with WorkSafeBC and municipal procedures.
- Effective communication skills and the ability to provide respectful and helpful service to the public.
