



CONSERVATION TIPS

- Water between dusk and dawn.
- Embrace xeriscape with drought-tolerant plantings.
- Sprinkle water not pavement.
- Tune up irrigation systems to ensure they are functioning properly.
- Water deeply but less often, most lawns need just 2.5 cm of water per week.
- Water stays longer when grass is longer (5-8 cm).
- Aerate your lawn in spring or fall to improve water penetration. Water works best with compost, which minimizes over-fertilizing.
- Leave grass clippings as mulch.
- Save water on shrubs, trees and gardens with drip irrigation.
- Collect and use rainwater.

GENERAL

REGULATIONS

Unless otherwise announced, the District of Peachland is always at **STAGE 1 Water Restrictions**. These regulations apply to all residential, commercial and other non-agricultural properties.

No watering is allowed between 10 am and 7 pm on any day, any time of year.

Hand watering of gardens is always allowed (by hose with shut-off valve).

STAGE 1

Alternate Days Watering

Even numbered addresses
Water on Even Calendar Days

Odd numbered addresses
Water on Odd Calendar Days

ON PERMITTED DAYS:

Automatic/Underground:
Water between midnight and 6 am

Manually Controlled:
Water between 6 am and 10 am and
7 pm to 11 pm

Note:

Only one ½" (9mm) diameter outlet may be used at one time for sprinkling.

No irrigation with open pipe or hose allowed.

STAGE 2

Twice a Week Watering

Even numbered addresses
Water on Saturdays and Tuesdays

Odd numbered addresses
Water on Sundays and Wednesdays

ON PERMITTED DAYS:

Automatic/Underground:
Water between midnight and 6 am

Manually Controlled:
Water between 6 am to 10 am and
7 pm to 11 pm

STAGE 3

Once a Week Watering

Even numbered addresses
Water on Saturdays

Odd numbered addresses
Water on Sundays

ON PERMITTED DAYS:

Automatic/Underground:
Water between midnight and 6 am

Manually Controlled:
Water between 6 am to 10 am and
7 pm to 11 pm

Note:

Filling a swimming pool, hot tub, garden pond or decorative fountain is not allowed.

Washing a vehicle or a boat with water is not allowed.

STAGE 4

No Outdoor Watering

No watering outdoors for any purpose.

Exemptions and special permissions may apply. Agricultural properties are restricted to watering between April 15 and October 30 unless otherwise authorized. Regulations are outlined in full in **Water Use Restrictions Bylaw #1688** and **Water Regulations Bylaw #1896** available at www.peachland.ca/bylaws.
